What is vaping?

- It is an Epidemic, involving everyone -Even high school and middle school students.
- It is the act of inhaling an aerosol produced by an e-cigarette

Did you know?

- 28% of NHS students report using e-cigs on a regular basis
- 24% of NHS students who vape report some level of craving
- 16% of NHS students who report vaping cannot quit

E-CIGARETTE USE IS NOT SAFE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE.




"Juul" is a popular nicotine vaping device

E-cigarette aerosol is not harmless. It can contain harmful ingredients. However, e-cigarette aerosol generally contains fewer harmful chemicals than smoke from burned tobacco products, like regular cigarettes.

The Facts

- E-cigarettes can be used to vape marijuana
- Adolescents who vape are
 5 times more likely to
 use cigarettes (JAMA Pediatrics)
- Youth may have access to e-cigarettes through friends who vape or online stores that accept gift cards

Signs your teen may be vaping

Moody and jittery behavior: nicotine cravings and or withdrawals can impact mood

Excessive Spending: funding a vaping habit is very costly

Mysteriously leaving for periods of time: Leaving so he/she can vape

Fruity or unusual smells: Vaping can produce smells from the flavors even if there is no smoke

Communication is Important!
